**“Chasing the Internet—Is the Law Keeping Up?”**

Dean Rodney Smolla will moderate a lively panel of respected legal authorities presented with two provoking hypotheticals based on real-life problems posed by the use and abuse of the Internet. The first relates to scandalous online postings by a law student and the second relates to comments posted online by a law school faculty member threatening national security. The panelists will be asked to place themselves in the shoes of a cast of characters addressing the legal issues presented as they unfold through the legal system. The audience members will ultimately be asked to assume the role of members of the Supreme Court of the United States as each situation reaches that level.

**Rodney A. Smolla** – *Dean and Roy L. Steinheimer, Jr. Professor of Law, Washington and Lee University School of Law, Lexington.* Dean Smolla was recently selected to become president of Furman University on July 1. He is a nationally acclaimed speaker and author on First Amendment issues, including: *Jerry Falwell v. Larry Flynt: The First Amendment on Trial* {St. Martin’s Press 1988}; and *Deliberate Intent* {Crown Publishers 1999}, which describes Dean Smolla’s involvement in the notorious Hit Man case, in which he successfully represented the families of three murder victims in a suit against the publisher of a murder instruction manual used by a hit man for instructions in carrying out the murders.

**Thomas E. Albro** – *Partner, Tremblay & Smith, Charlottesville.* Mr. Albro devotes a significant portion of his law practice to defamation law and civil litigation.

**David P. Baugh** – *Capital Defender-Central, Virginia Indigent Defense Commission, Richmond.* Prior to becoming the Capital Defender in Richmond, Mr. Baugh was in private practice concentrating on criminal law. He is well-known for his representation in First Amendment cases.

**Hon. B. Waugh Crigler** – *Magistrate Judge, U.S. District Court, Western District of Virginia, Charlottesville.* Judge Crigler serves on the Board of Governors of the Litigation Section and the Section on the Education of Lawyers of the Virginia State Bar. He is a former Vice Chair of the Virginia State Bar’s Standing Committee on Professionalism, and has served as a member of The Virginia Bar Association’s Commission on Professionalism since 2006.

**Richard Cullen** – *Partner/Chairman, McGuireWoods, Richmond.* Mr. Cullen served as United States Attorney for the Eastern District of Virginia from 1991 to 1993. He was later appointed Attorney General of Virginia.

**Davison M. Douglas** – *Dean and Arthur B. Hanson Professor of Law, William & Mary Law School, Williamsburg.* Dean Douglas joined the William & Mary law faculty in 1990. From 1997 until 2003, he served as Director of William & Mary’s nationally acclaimed Institute of Bill of Rights Law. He is one of the nation’s leading constitutional historians and has published numerous writings in this area.

**John G. Douglass** – *Dean and Professor of Law, University of Richmond School of Law, Richmond.* Dean Douglass’s academic publications have focused on prosecution, the criminal trial process and the Confrontation Clause. Before joining the Richmond Law Faculty in 1996, he practiced law for 15 years. Dean Douglass served for eight years as an Assistant United States Attorney in Baltimore and in Richmond, and was Chief of the Criminal Division in the Office of the United States Attorney in Richmond from 1992 to 1996.

**James Gibson** – *Professor of Law and Director, Intellectual Property Institute, University of Richmond School of Law, Richmond.* Professor Gibson teaches intellectual property, computer law, and contracts at the University of Richmond School of Law, and is director of the school’s Intellectual Property Institute. He frequently writes, speaks, and consults on the relationship between new technologies and legal entitlements, and his scholarship has appeared in the *Yale Law Journal*, the *Virginia Law Review*, and elsewhere.

**Hon. S. Bernard Goodwyn** – *Justice, Supreme Court of Virginia, Richmond.* Justice Goodwyn was a partner in the commercial litigation section with Willcox & Savage until 1995. In 1994 he took a leave of absence to serve as Research Associate Professor of Law at the University of Virginia where he taught Federal Civil Procedure, Virginia Civil Procedure and Civil Litigation Practice. In 1995, Justice Goodwyn was appointed by the legislature as Judge, General District Court, First Judicial District, in Chesapeake. He was elevated to the Circuit Court bench in Chesapeake in 1997, and to the Supreme Court of Virginia in 2007.

**Karen A. Gould** – *Executive Director, Virginia State Bar, Richmond.* Prior to assuming her current position in 2007, Ms. Gould was in private practice as a trial lawyer for over 20 years, including four years in the Office of the Attorney General of Virginia.

**Timothy J. Heaphy** – *United States Attorney, Western District of Virginia, Roanoke.* Mr. Heaphy is a former prosecutor, law professor and white-collar criminal defense attorney.

**Leanne M. Shank** – *General Counsel, Washington & Lee University, Lexington.*

**Hon. Wilford Taylor, Jr.** – *Chief Judge, Eighth Judicial Circuit, Hampton.* Judge Taylor serves as an adjunct professor at the William and Mary Law School in Williamsburg.

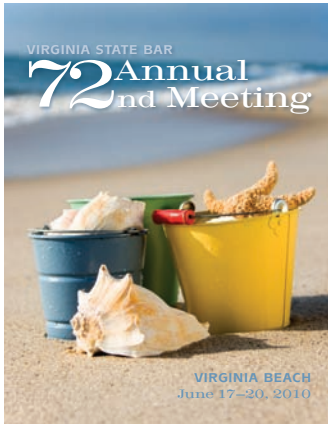
